Landfills Transfer Stations Compost Facilities



Illinois EPA's float won the "Director's Award for Best Non-Commercial Entry" in the Illinois State Fair opening Twilight Parade on August 10, 2006. The race car was constructed primarily by students in the Governor's Environmental Corps from aluminum cans, plastic containers and other recyclable items. It was also on display at the DuQuoin State Fair.

WASTE LANDFILLED IN WEST CENTRAL ILLINOIS (REGION Five) during 2005 amounted to only 4.2 percent of the state's total, the lowest in the state. Nevertheless, the landfills serve their purposes locally.

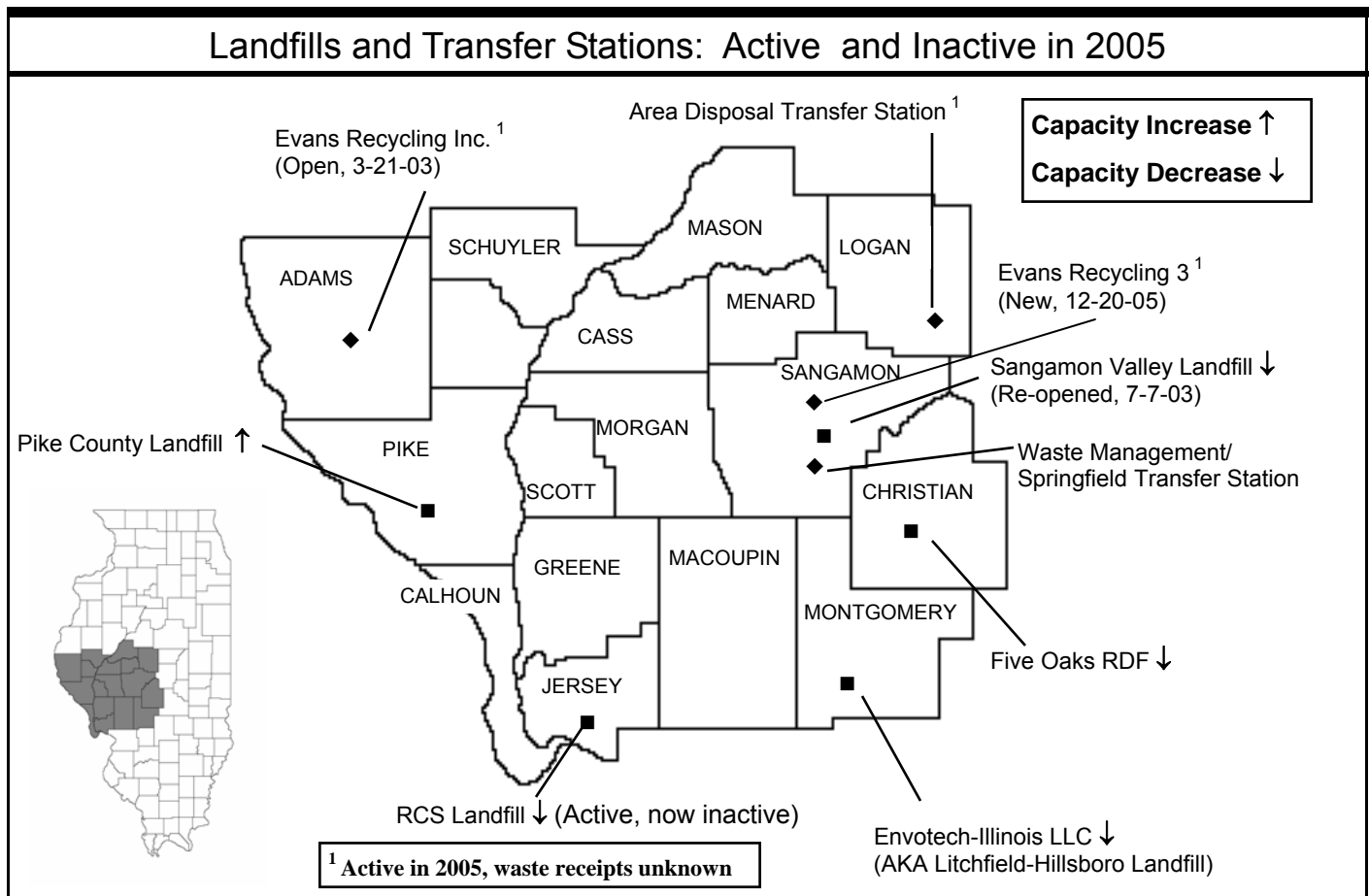
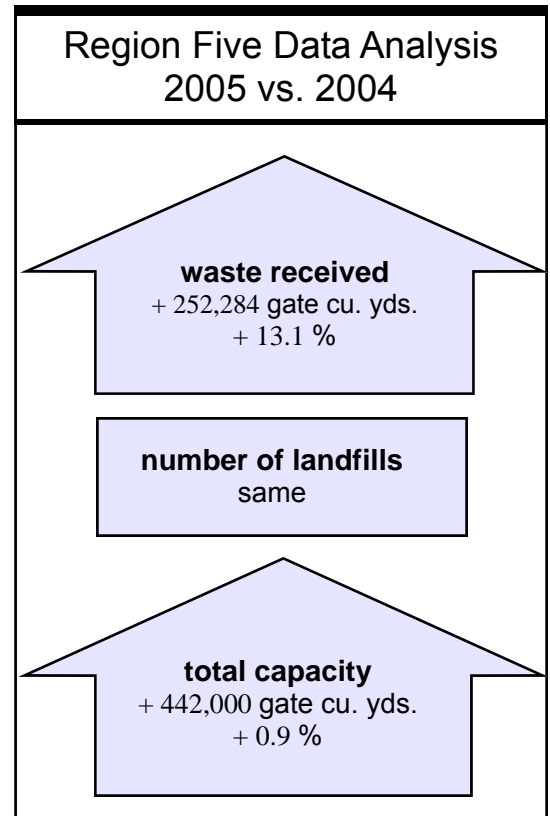
Region Five's five active landfills accepted almost 2.2 million gate cubic yards of waste during 2005. This volume differed slightly from 2004's total waste landfilled by adding 13.1 percent, or an increase of 252,284 gate cubic yards.

Landfill life exceeds statewide average

As a region, West Central Illinois has the third most landfill life remaining: 23 years; Southern Illinois (Region 7) at 51 years and Region Three (Peoria/Quad Cities) at 46 years have more years of landfill life remaining. On the low end, Chicago Metropolitan Area (Region 2) has 11 years remaining. The whole state has 19 years of landfill capacity left.

The region's capacity increased by 442,000 gate cubic yards as reported on Jan. 1, 2006, just a 0.9 percent increase from the previous year.

Five Oaks Recycling and Disposal Facility, Taylorville, is ranked ninth in terms of capacity remaining at Illinois landfills as of Jan. 1, 2006, with 29.2 million gate cubic yards of capacity remaining.

Sangamon Valley Landfill re-opened in July 2003

Sangamon Valley Landfill re-opened in the latter part of 2003, under its new operators. Sangamon Valley Landfill's owners re-activated a site that had been inactive since 1995 (with Illinois EPA's approval) on July 7, 2003, when the operators opened Cell 1A, Area II. New areas have been built since then: Cell 1B, on Aug. 9, 2004; Cell 2A on May 26, 2005 and Cell 2B on Aug. 12, 2005.

New cells open at three other landfills

Cell 7, Phase 2B (4.1 acres) opened at Envotech-Illinois LLC, Litchfield, on Dec. 22, 2003. On Jan. 16, 2004, Pike County Landfill received a permit to operate Phases 10 and 11A, adding 5.2 acres to their permitted disposal area. On Jan. 25, 2005, RCS Inc. Landfill, Jerseyville, opened Cell #2 (side slope) and Cell #3A, adding 3.5 acres to their operating disposal area. A year later though the operators ceased accepting waste at this landfill and moved staff to their landfill in Roxana.

Three counties have delegation agreements

The Illinois EPA has delegated inspection authority to the Christian County Solid Waste Management Department, Montgomery County Coordinated Services Office and Sangamon County Department of Public Health.

Delegation agreements authorize these agencies to conduct many of the duties that would otherwise have to be performed by the Illinois EPA's Springfield field office: investigating and enforcing suspected violations of land pollution laws and reports of open dumping, and inspecting landfills, transfer stations and compost facilities permitted through the Agency's Bureau of Land.

(Inspections also include nonhazardous industrial waste landfills, or monofills, and landfills that closed prior to 2003; these facilities are not included in this report.)

Christian and Montgomery counties each have one active landfill. Sangamon County's landfill was re-activated in 2003.

Sangamon County has an active transfer station; Montgomery County and Christian County do not. Sangamon County also has an active compost facility.

Transfer station's activity in 2005 is largely from the capital city of Springfield

Only one of Region Five's four transfer stations voluntarily reported accepting municipal waste during 2005. This means that 153,450 tons of waste reported as being transferred tells only part of the story.

Evans Recycling Inc. operates landscape waste transfer operations in Quincy and Springfield. Quincy's site has been opened since Mar. 21, 2003 and Springfield's site, since Dec. 20, 2005.

One compost site in the region receives landscape waste

Sixty gate tons of landscape wastes (an amount less than one percent of regional wastes landfilled) were processed through the region's only compost site active in 2005. Dirksen Parkway Compost Facility manages landscape waste generated from the State Capitol complex in downtown Springfield. Its permit was renewed on Sept. 8, 2005.

Quincy Compost Facility, Quincy, was certified closed on July 30, 2003.

Municipal Waste Management Plans

The Solid Waste Planning and Recycling Act requires all Illinois counties and the City of Chicago to develop, adopt and implement 20-year municipal waste management plans.

Plans include programs and recommendations to achieve solid waste management goals, which typically include waste reduction, recycling, incineration and landfilling as program options.

The law requires each plan to include a program designed to recycle 15 percent of municipal waste by the end of the third year of the program and 25 percent of municipal waste by the end of the fifth year, depending upon the availability of markets.

Every five years, each plan must identify changes in planning areas, evaluate progress in plan implementation and, if necessary, revise plan recommendations and goals. The county also has the option of updating its solid waste generation rate. The plan is then submitted to the Illinois EPA for review and comment.

Five year plan updates have been adopted by Brown, Calhoun, Cass, Christian, Greene, Logan, Macoupin, Mason, Menard, Montgomery, Morgan, Pike, Sangamon, Schuyler and Scott counties.

Additionally, Christian, Jersey, Logan, Menard, Morgan and Sangamon counties completed their ten year plan updates.

Multiple year recycling rates average 22.7 percent

Each year, Illinois EPA attempts to seek recycling and waste generation data from county recycling coordinators.

Four recycling coordinators (of 17 counties) in Region Five provided new data for 2005, a 23.5 percent response rate.

The multi-year average for the entire region, which includes recycling data from 1992 to 2005, is 22.7 percent. ♦
