Production Information

There are 5 hog facilities and 22 fields that compromise this operation. The facility is a 6,300 sow farrow to wean facility that has the maximum animal capacity of 7,242 animals. There is adequate manure storage for the number of animals that are housed at the site. More detailed description of the facilities are located in section 6 and 6 of this CNMP. A map depicting operation locations and fields can be found attached to this document.

Applicable Permits

Under the Livestock Management Facilities Act (LMFA) these facilities are required to develop and maintain operating records which will be retained for a period of five years.

Land Application Site Information

All the manure produced from this operation is recycled to the land as nutrients for growing crops. This is an environmentally sound use of this material as long as it is properly applied and managed. The primary concerns for land application are matching manure application to the nutrient needs of the crops and soils and protecting sensitive areas during application. The primary sensitive areas that have been identified are fields that have the closest proximity to water.

Manure Application Plans

Manure is applied to the cropland based on realistic, proven yield goals and the existing nutrient level of the soil. According to the nutrient budget approximately 350 acres being planted to corn will be required each year for the proper land application of the manure that is produced from this facility. Manure will not necessarily be applied to all acreage each year. Application sites will be rotated to avoid the excessive buildup of nutrients in the soil.

To meet Dept. of Ag requirements, you need to:

Soil Test

Take annual manure analyses (at least until stable)

Apply at agronomic rates according to analyses

Obey setbacks

200' from water

200' from wells

¼ mi. from residences IF you have to surface apply

no setback from residences IF injecting

To meet CAFO requirements:

You do NOT need a NPDES permit, UNLESS you discharge

Your facility should be a “no discharge” facility, EXCEPT in the case of a tanker turnover or accident, or drag hose rupture AND that spill reaches a “navigable water” (navigable is yet to be defined)

You DO NOT have a discharge based on land application (i.e. large unexpected rainfall after an application causes a fish kill downstream), IF you have a nutrient management plan, AND you are following it!

As the owner/operator of this CNMP, I, as the decision maker, have been involved in the planning process and agree that the items/practices listed in each element of the CNMP are needed. I understand that I am responsible for keeping all the necessary records associated with the implementation of this CNMP. It is my intention to implement/accomplish this CNMP in a timely manner as described in the plan.
