Dear Mr. Darrah:

The application for permit received October 25, 2004 for the above listed project has been reviewed and has been determined to be an incomplete submission for purposes of review towards the issuance of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit.


The following specific additional information must be submitted in order to continue our review:

1. Please provide a stormwater management plan for the concentrated animal feeding operation that will be covered under this NPDES permit. This plan must address stormwater runoff collection, treatment, controls, good housekeeping and preventative maintenance activities, and monthly visual inspection procedures for:
  - a. Immediate access roads used or traveled by carriers of raw materials, waste materials, by-products, or products used or created by the facility;
  - b. Sites used for the handling of material other than livestock waste;
  - c. Refuse sites;
  - d. Swine mortality handling and storage areas;
  - e. Sites used for the storage or maintenance of material handling equipment; and
  - f. Shipping and receiving areas.
  
2. Please provide a statement that the nutrient management plan, stormwater plan and spill control plan will include the discharge limitation, field application of livestock waste, monitoring and reporting requirements, and release provisions of the general NPDES permit IL00A01, or that if an individual permit is to be issued, the aforementioned plans will contain the same provisions.

If for any reason you cannot supply the above requested information within 30 days, please explain the reasons in writing and state when the information will be submitted. Failure to respond with the requested documents, information and plans could be cause for Denial of your NPDES permit. Please include NPDES permit number listed above in all your correspondence to our office.
