On behalf of our client, Bradshaw Enterprises, please find following responses to your last letter dated December 18, 2012.

The Narrative Waste Recycling Plan included in the previous NMP has been removed. It is replaced with the attached Narrative Rate Plan.

Also, please find the following responses to Items 1 and 2 from your August 28, 2012 letter:

- f. An aerial photos of 5 fields which may be used for waste application by the third party hauler is included in the original NMP.
- g. The facility owner operator contracts with a third party hauler for pumping and land application of waste holding pond effluent. See also attached agreement for third party hauler to sign, part of Narrative Rate Plan in Section 8.

n. See Narrative Rate Plan in Section 8 for listing of fields.


2. 8IL. Adm. Code Section 900.810 a. and b.
