

Special Conditions**Construction Authorization**

The facility consists of two existing independently operated but adjoining and commonly owned limestone quarries. The two facilities are the 50 acre limestone quarry designated as Casper Stolle Quarry (Facility A) and the the 200 acre Falling Springs Quarry (Facility B), both owned and operated by Casper Stolle Quarry & Contracting Company. The two facilities are located in Sections 13 and 14, Township 1N, Range 10W of the 3rd P.M. in St. Clair County, Illinois near Dupo. Mining operations include blasting, crushing, conveying, stockpiling and hauling of limestone aggregate deposits. An asphalt concrete plant identified as Maclair Asphalt Sales, LLC is operated on the premises of Facility (B). Mine operations at facility B including the asphalt plant do not result in a discharge to waters of the State. Mine activities include the removal of overburden for sale as fill material or for use on-site as fill within previously mined areas. Mine operations at Facility (A) result in the discharge to waters of the U.S., these discharges consist of pit dewatering flow and stormwater runoff from outfall 001 at an average discharge rate of 0.36 MGD to Old Prairie Du Pont Creek.

Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan: Authorization is hereby granted to construct treatment works and related equipment that may be required by the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan developed pursuant to this permit. Discharging sedimentation ponds are not covered under the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan authorization, unless they discharge to a non-coal outfall specifically identified in a construction authorization under this permit.

This Authorization is issued subject to the following condition(s).

- a. If any statement or representation is found to be incorrect, this authorization may be revoked and the permittee thereupon waives all rights thereunder.
- b. Plans and specifications of all treatment equipment being included as a part of the storm water management practice shall be included in the SWPPP.
- c. Any modification of or deviation from the plans and specifications in the initial SWPPP requires amendment of the SWPPP.
- d. Construction activities which result from treatment equipment installation, including clearing, grading and excavation activities which result in the disturbance of land area must meet the conditions of this permit.
